 5. Chain 3.
 6. Double crochet in the next double crochet and in each double crochet around. (11 double crochets)
 7. Slip stitch to the third chain to form a ring.
 8. Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

Step 3: Attach the Flowers to the Headband

1. Sew the flowers to the headband, spacing them evenly around.
2. Weave in any loose ends.

Tips

- To make a wider headband, chain more stitches in step 1.
- To make a narrower headband, chain fewer stitches in step 1.
- To make the flowers larger, use a larger crochet hook.
- To make the flowers smaller, use a smaller crochet hook.
- To make the headband more durable, use a stronger yarn.

- To make the headband more comfortable, use a softer yarn.
